G.Nicolais is a clinical psychologist, Associate Professor of Developmental Psychology, Sapienza University of Rome, Italy. He received his B.A. in Psychology from “Sapienza”, where he also completed his postgraduate education with a Psy.D. training in child, adolescent and adult clinical psychology and psychotherapy, and a Ph.D. in clinical child psychology.

He’s been practicing for two decades as a psychologist and psychotherapist in the areas of developmental psychopathology and childhood trauma. His main research interests are in the field of developmental psychopathology, attachment, child trauma and its intergenerational transmission, early moral development. He’s currently member of the World Association of Infant Mental Health – WAIMH.

The main aim of the seminar is to encourage reflections and dialogue around clinical intervention with childhood trauma. In the first part of the seminar, psychological trauma will be defined in the light of the activation of attachment as a system evolved for the regulation of fear and overwhelming emotions. With this respect, disorganized attachment will be introduced as the earliest form of dissociation in the face of trauma. The second part of the seminar will introduce principles of intervention with children affected by complex trauma, as well as treatment approaches for different traumatic conditions.
