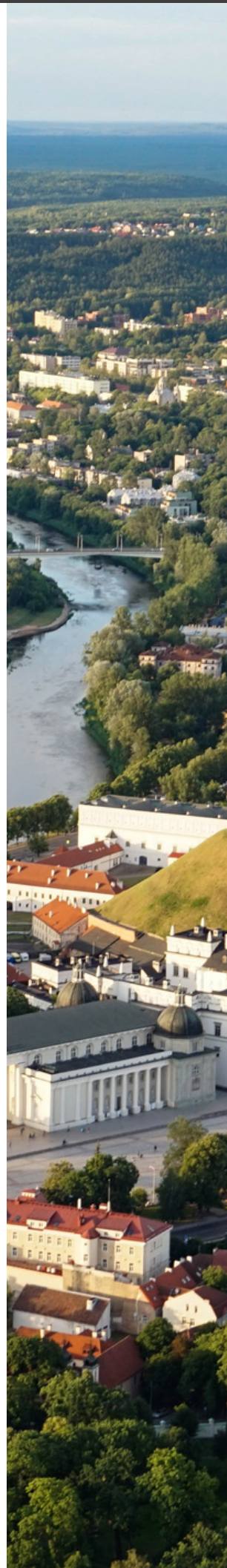

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ABOUT THE WORKSHOPS

During the ARQ I-AM-PhD Vilnius, there will be four workshop sessions. All participants will participate in the first *Presentations* workshop. Participants can choose which three workshops to participate in after that.

Presentations During the first workshop session, the participants will have the opportunity to briefly present their research projects in small groups.
