





STUDY FACILITIES AT VILNIUS UNIVERSITY

The Old Library: one of the richest collections of old books, historical documents and manuscripts. Distance: next to the Faculty of Philosophy.

Scholarly Communication and Inf ormation Centre (SCIC): modern library, open 24/7, providing working places equipped with c omputers, lounge chairs for discussions / relaxation, silent reading room, reading room for students with children, room for individual work for professors and PhD students. Distance: in reach within 15 minutes by public transport traveling from the Faculty of Philosophy.

Computer facilities: computers are available at the Faculty of Philosophy computer classroom (20 computers). Computers with printers and scanners available at all Vilnius University libraries. Free unlimited WiFi across all University campuses.
